## 1. What salinose Hypertonic Nasal Jet Spray is and what it is used for

salinose Hypertonic Nasal Jet Spray called "salinose Hypertonic in this leaflet", it is a hypertonic solution (2.65% w/v NaCl) to moisten and cleanse the nose. salinose Hypertonic helps you breathe better. Useful as a nasal wash for sinuses and colds, and to flush allergens and dust from nasal passages.

## 2. What you need to know before you use salinose Hypertonic Nasal Jet Spray

## Warnings and precautions

For nasal use only. Do not use this container for more than one person; it may spread infection.

#### Children and adolescents

Used in adults and children from 6 years old and above only. **Pregnancy and breastfeeding** 

If you are pregnant or breastfeeding or think you may be pregnant, ask your doctor or pharmacist for advice before taking this product.

## 3. How to use salinose Hypertonic Nasal Jet Spray

Can be used alone, as a natural alternative to medicated decongestants (local corticosteroids, antihistamines, vasoconstrictors), or in combination with them to improve their efficacy. As such, it helps decrease medicated treatment duration and may lead to reduced overall drug intake.

#### Instruction for use:

#### Adult & Children

- 1. Remove protective cap
- 2. Hold head upright position,
- 3. Gently insert applicator into the nostril and press firmly
- 4. Spray twice in each nostril.

Use 2 or 3 times daily as needed, or as recommended by your doctor. Take care not to aspirate nasal contents back into bottle. If spray tip touches nose, rinse with hot water before replacing cap.

#### Recommended dosage:

salinose Hypertonic Nasal Jet Spray 75ml:

**Adult:** 1 to 3 sprays in each nostril, 2 to 3 times daily or as per physician's instructions.

## salinose Hypertonic Nasal Jet Spray

Sodium Chloride 2.65% w/v

**Children (6 years and above):** 1 to 2 sprays in each nostril, 2 to 3 times daily or as per physician's instructions.

## 4. Possible side effects

A mild and temporary stinging sensation may be experienced at the beginning of use.

## 5. How to store salinose Hypertonic Nasal Jet Spray

- Keep this medicine out of the sight and reach of children.
- · Store below 30°C.
- · Shelf life after first opening is 2 months.
- Do not use salinose Hypertonic after the expiry date which is stated on the label and carton. The expiry date refers to the last day of that month.
- Do not throw away any medicines via wastewater or household waste.
  Ask your pharmacist how to throw away medicines if you no longer use.
  These measures will help to protect the environment.
