## **Dosage & administration:**

Apply a thin film of **AVOCOM-M** cream to the affected skin areas once or twice daily.

## AVOCOM-M

Mometasone Furoate 0.1% w/w, Miconazole Nitrate 2% w/w

Composition: Each gram of Avocom-M Cream contains 1 mg of Mometasone Furoate and 20 mg of Miconazole Nitrate in a suitable cream base, Properties: Avocom-M Cream contains Mometasone Furoate, which is a synthetic medium potency corticosteroid, has anti inflammatory, anti-pruritic and anti-allergic actions. Miconazole Nitrate, which is a broad-spectrum antifungal agent against pathogenic fungi, including yeasts and dermotophytes. Indications: Avocom-M Cream is indicated for mixed infections of the skin with the fungi. These include: atopic eczema, contact eczema, follicular eczema, infantile eczema, citiis external, anogenital pruritus (pruritis ani/vulvae), numuular eczema, post traumatic infective eczema, seborrhoeic or flexural eczema, neurodermatitis and psoriasis. Dosage & administration: Apply a thin film of Avocom-M Cream to the affected skin areas once or twice daily. Side Effects: Extended, recurrent applications may increase the risk of contact sensitization. Contraindicated in patients who are hypersensitive to any ingredient in this preparation. Precautions: For external use only. - Systemic absorption of topical corticosteroid will be increased, if extensive technique is used. Suitable precautions should be taken under these conditions or when long-term use is anticipated, particularly in infants and children. - Use of topical corticosteroid in children should be limited to the least amount compatible with an effective therapeutic regimen. - If irritation or sensitization develop with the use of Avocom-M Cream treatment should be discontinued. - Excessive or prolonged use of topical corticosteroid can suppress HPA axis, resulting in secondary adrenal insufficiency. Pregnancy & breast-feeding: - Since safe use of Mometasone Furoate O.1% in pregnant women has not been established, topical corticosteroids be used during pregnancy, only if the potential benefit Justifies potential risk to the fetus. - It is not known whether topical administration of corticosteroids could be made, whether to Discontinue
